Our delicious three course meals are very reasonably priced and are subsidised by Boroondara Council and the Department of Human Services. We can also provide frozen, ready-to-enjoy meals for weekends and public holidays.

Our meals are carefully prepared on-site by professional staff in our purpose built kitchens.
